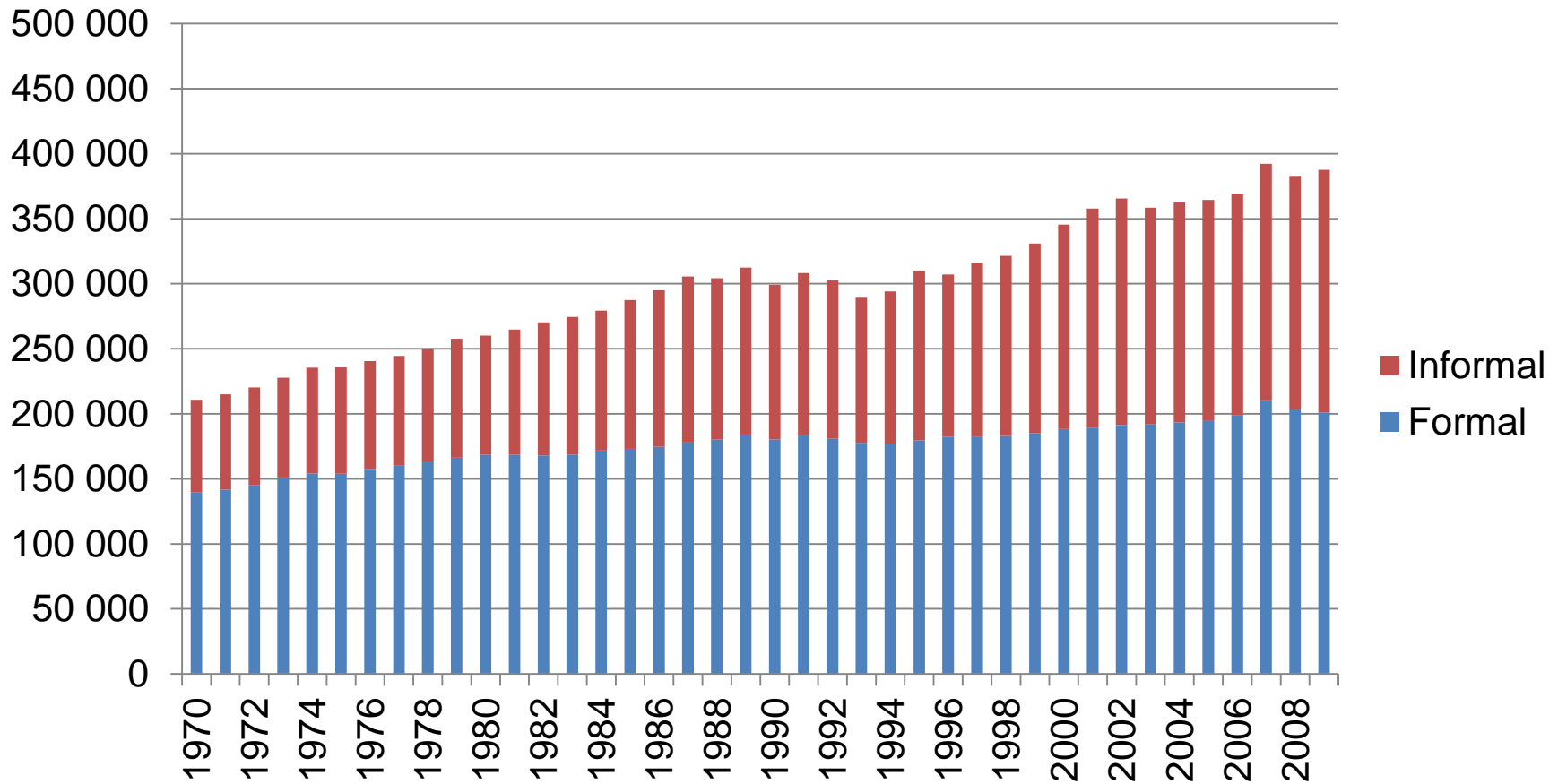

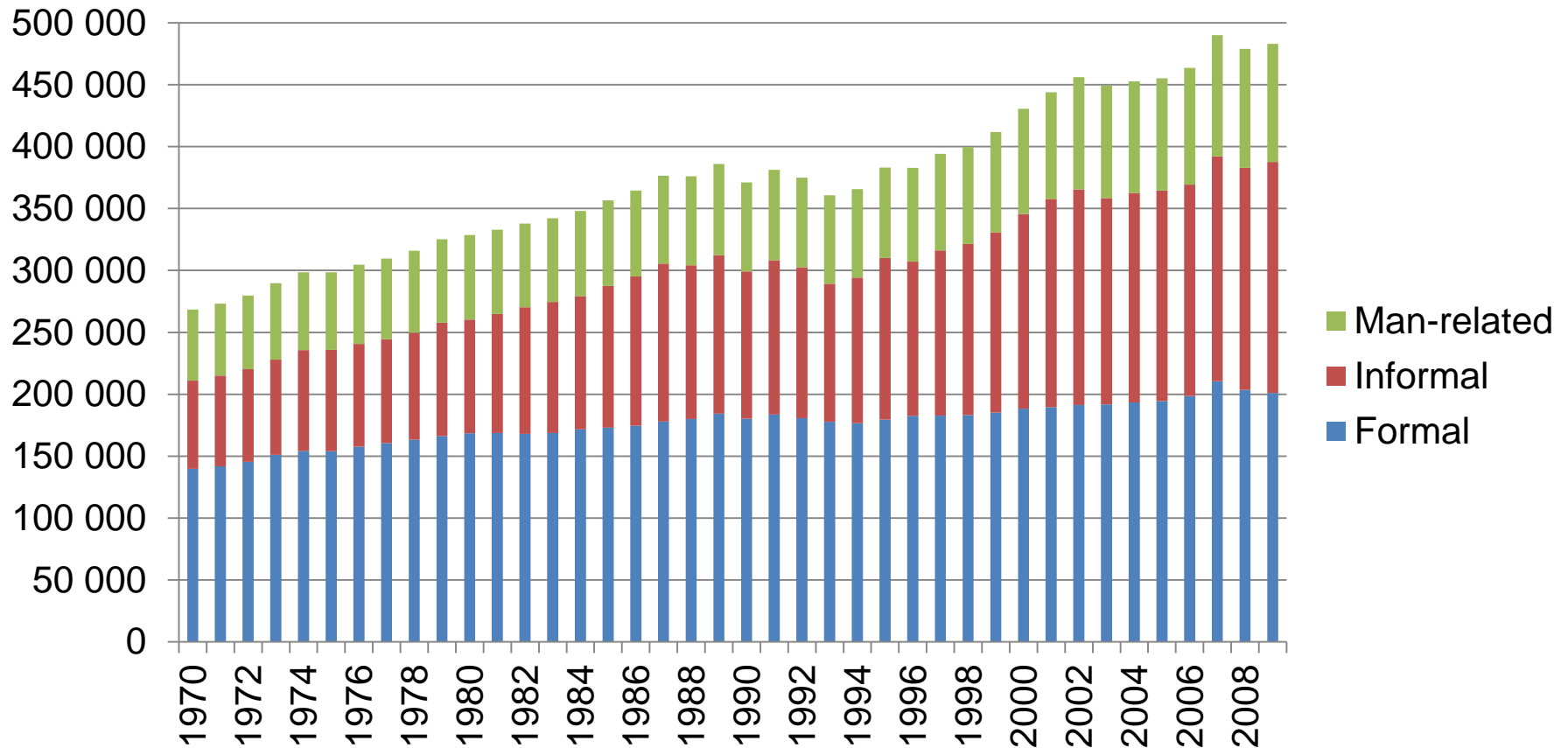

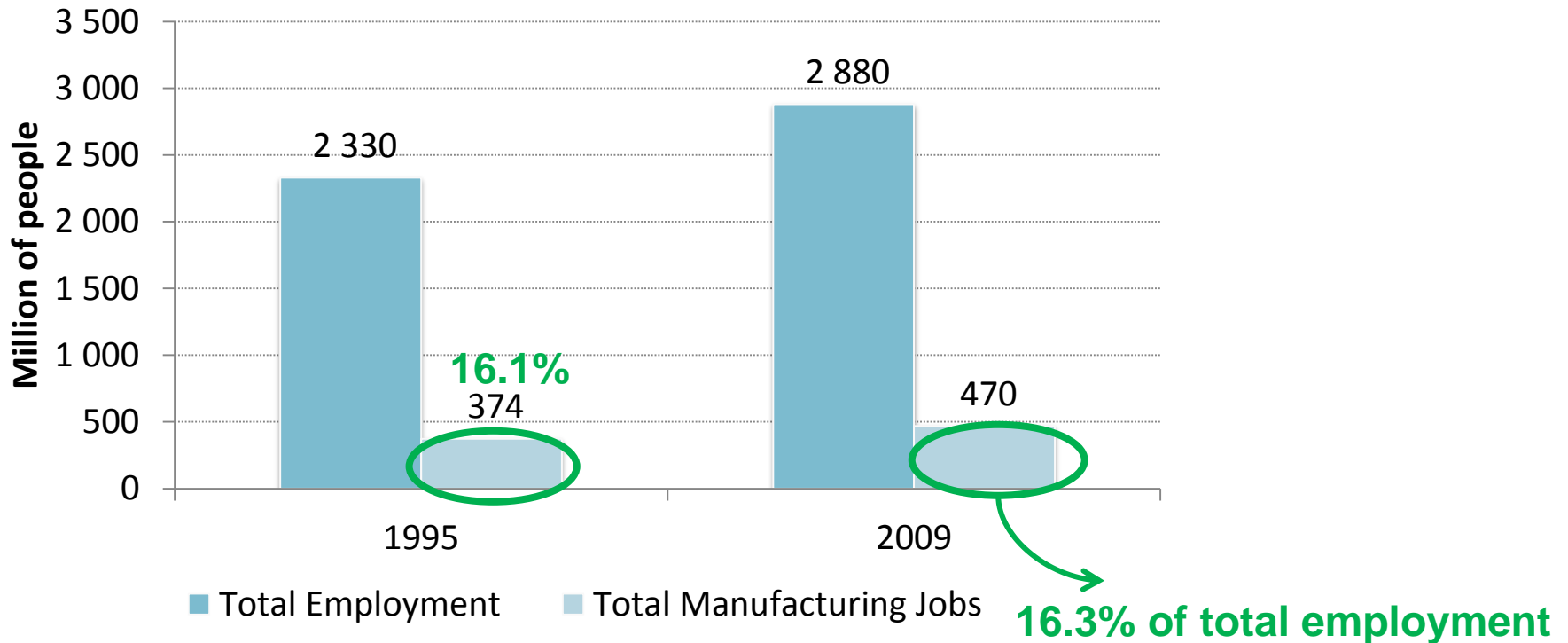
Manufacturing and Manufacturing-related service jobs



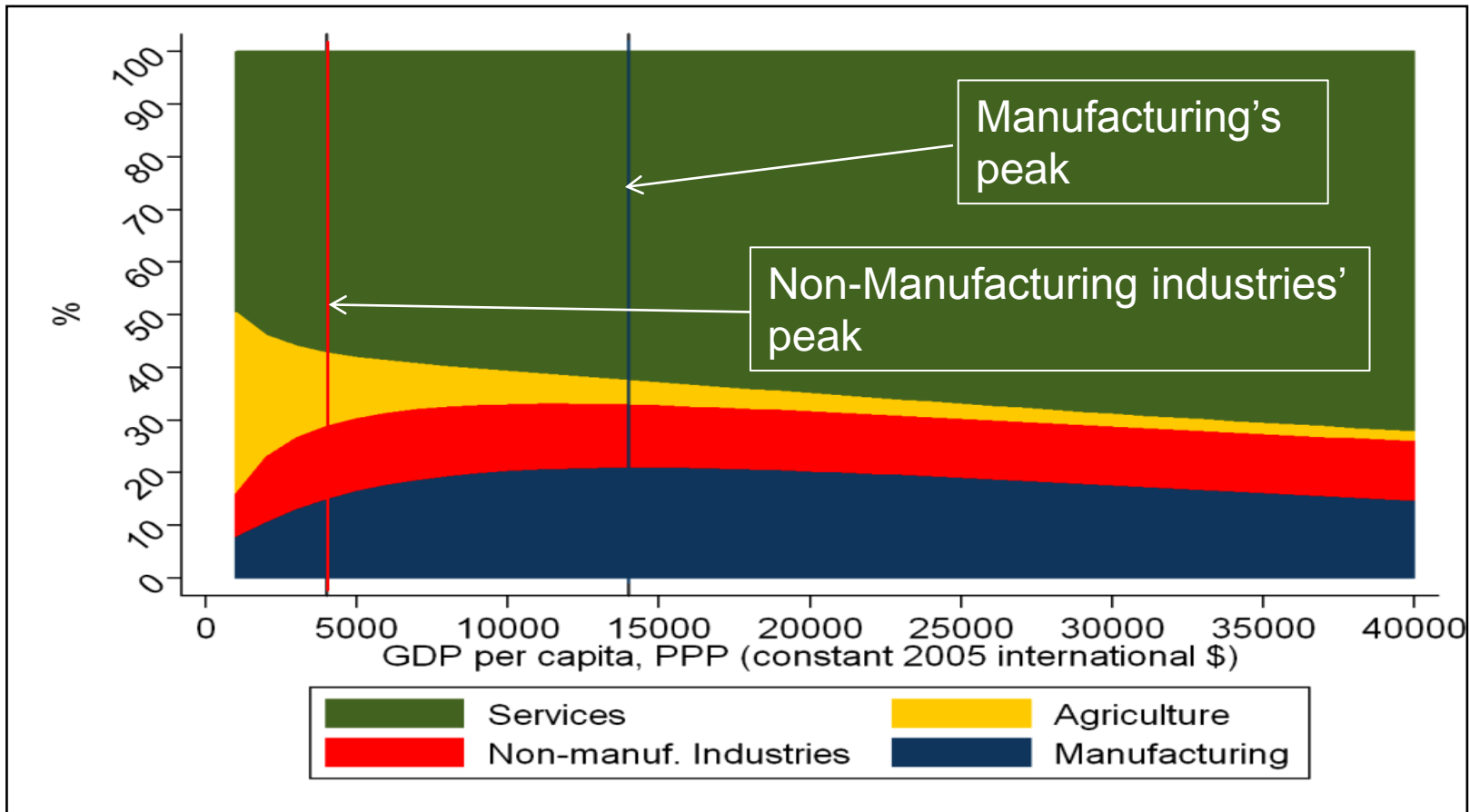

GDP composition by income and sector, 1963-2007

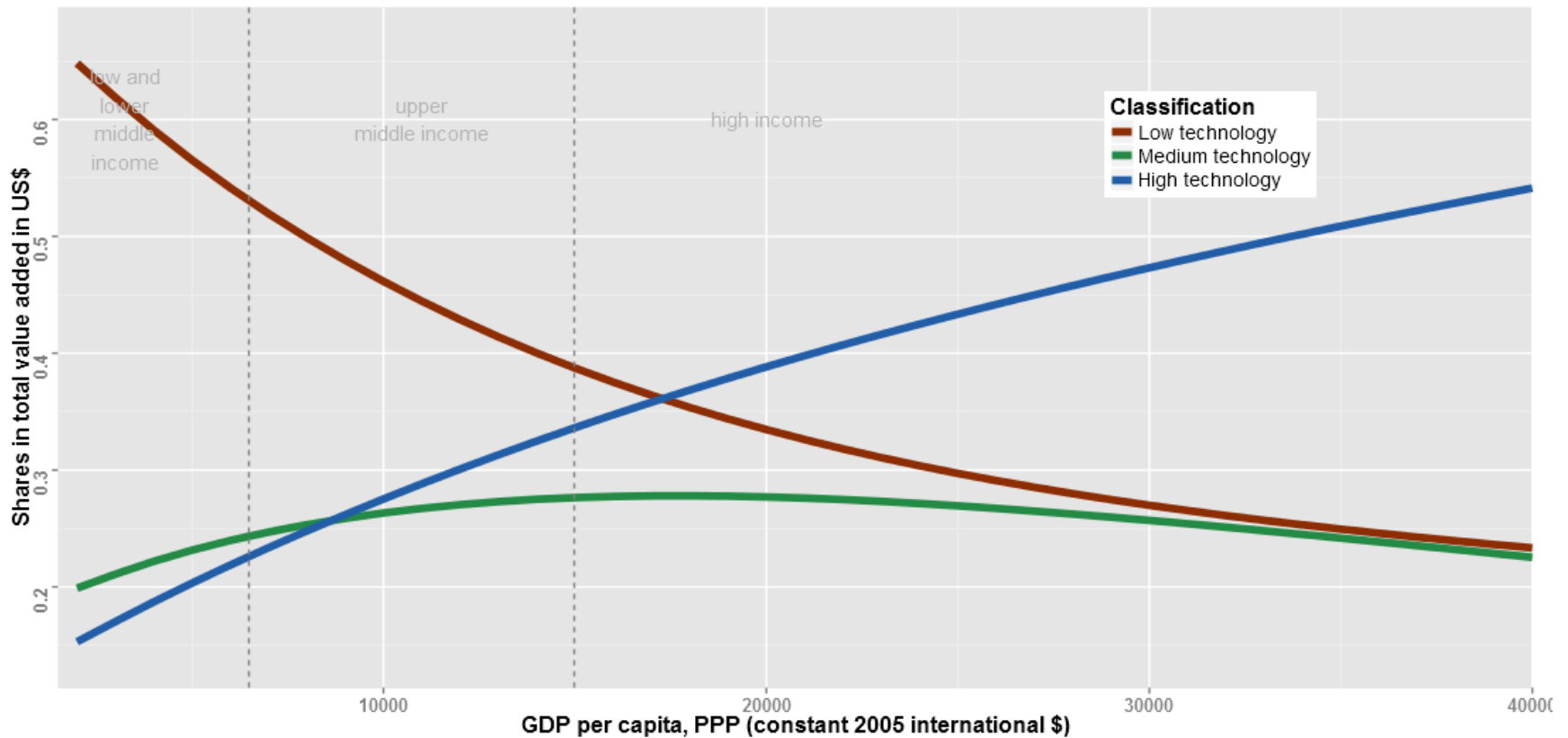
